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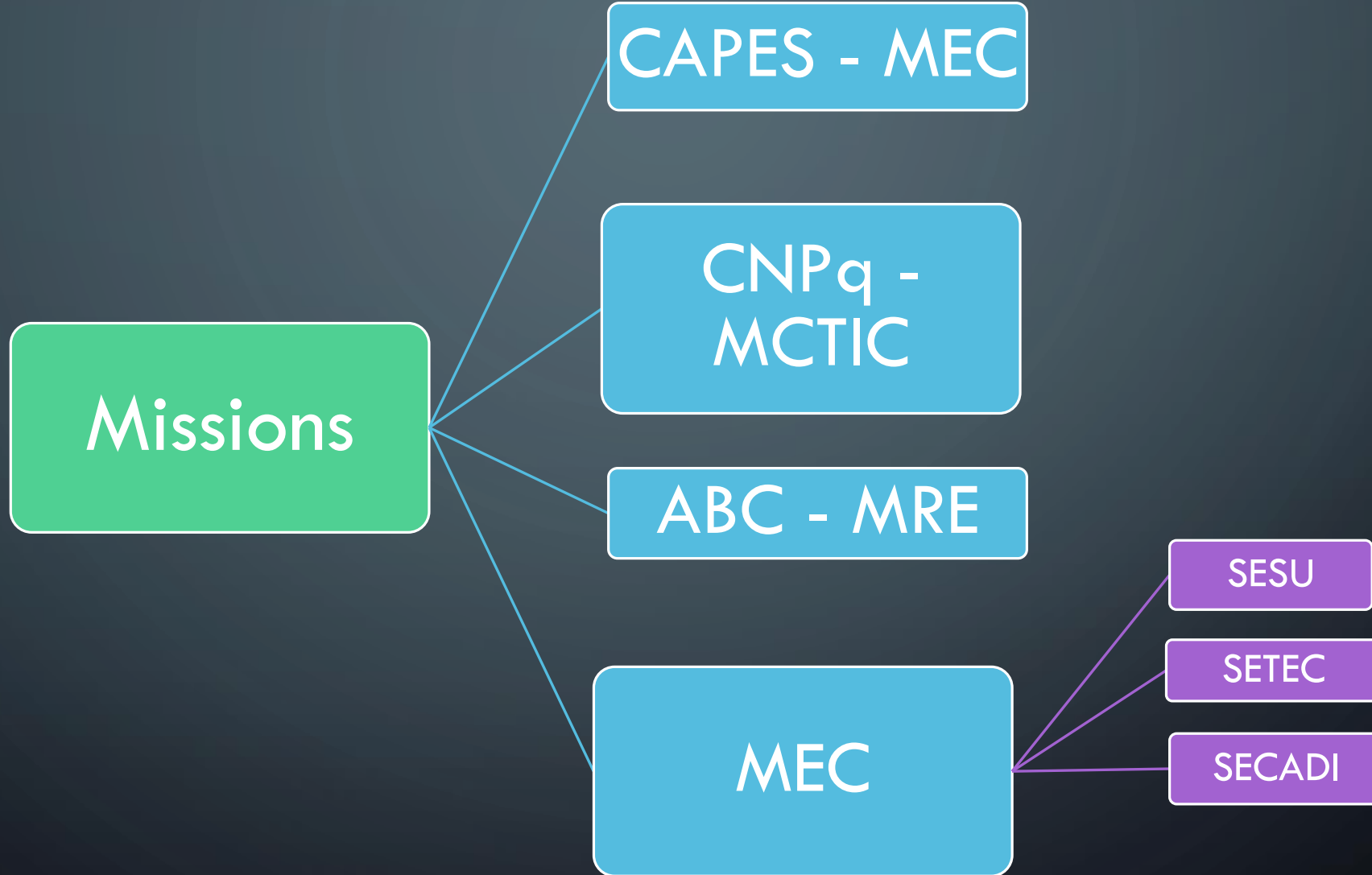

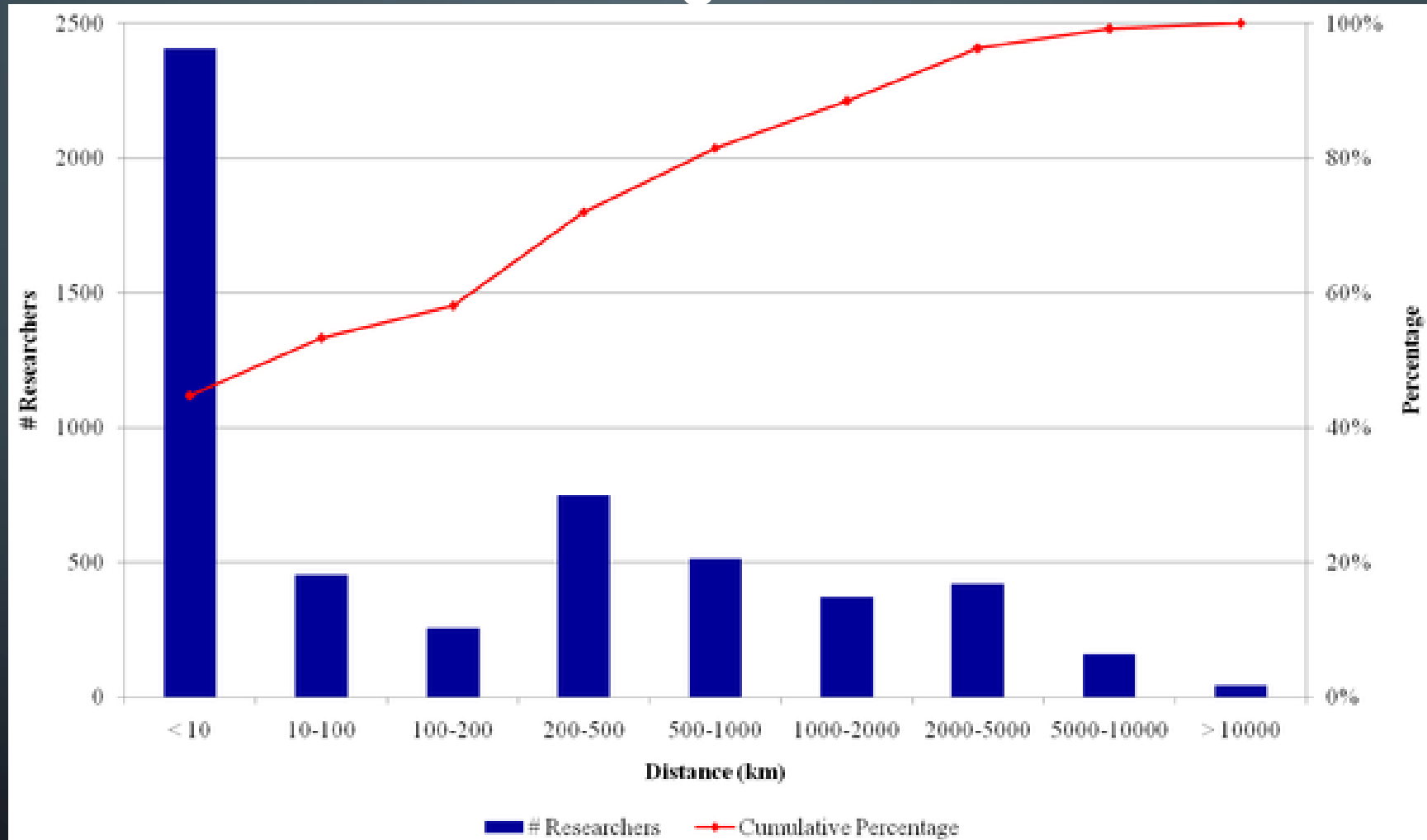

 - 71.82% with international relations office

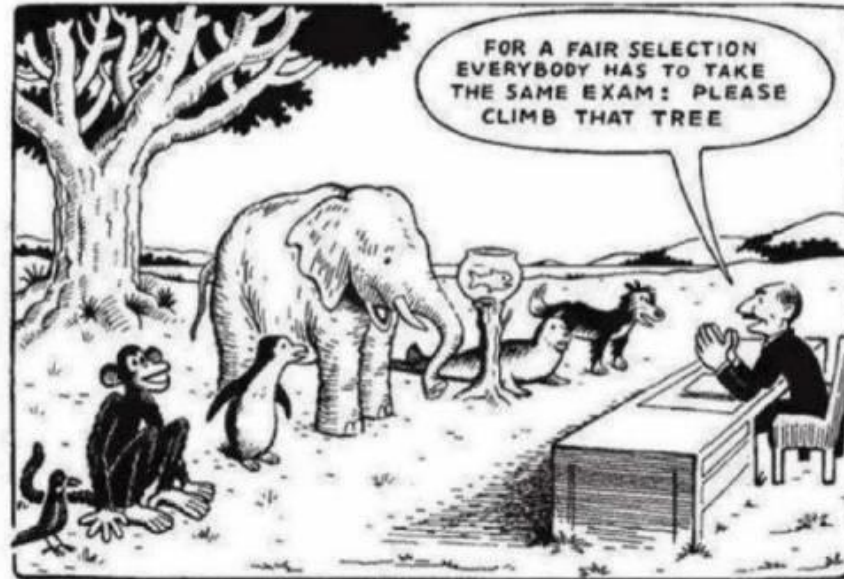

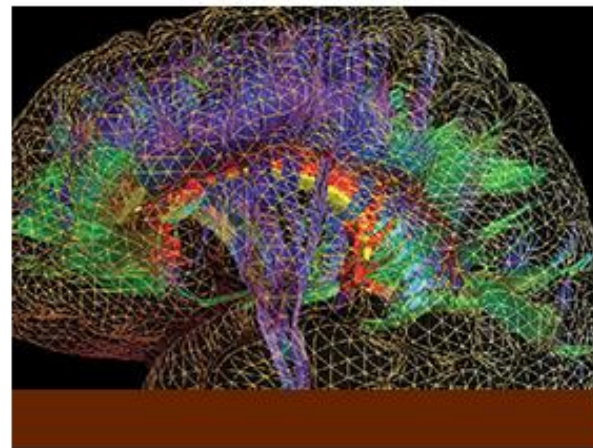

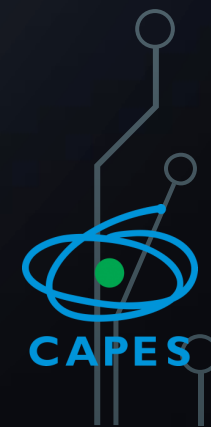
