
Overview of National Forum

- National advisory body for teaching and learning in higher education
- Working in partnership with the HEA, QQI, DES, representative bodies and staff and students across the sector
- 4 Priorities to 2021:
 - The professional development of those who teach
 - Teaching and learning within disciplines
 - Teaching and learning in a digital world
 - Enabling student success



Background

- National Professional Development Framework
- Focus on disciplines
- Idea to introduce disciplinary staff mobility scholarships
- Through existing systems





ERASMUS+ DELTA SCHOLARSHIP

Disciplinary Excellence in Learning, Teaching and Assessment



Overview

- Using the existing mobility process
- Application form is almost identical (just with different logo and extra information in appendix)
- Only applicable to those engaging in the training element of Erasmus+
- Provides opportunity for national recognition
- To claim recognition, they come back and share their learning with the Forum



Process

- Just one Erasmus+ Mobility Programme, this does not change
- Two options for embarking on Erasmus+ Mobility Programme
- We need people to declare beforehand if they are interested in the Delta Erasmus+ Scholarship
- If interested, they fill in the Delta Erasmus+ mobility application form
- They then go on their mobility programme and reach the targets they set

- On return:
 - Staff fill in the online Erasmus feedback form as usual
 - Erasmus+ Delta applicants also provide feedback through separate form to the National Forum, in order to claim recognition as Delta Scholars
 - Recognition will be in the form of a digital badge

- Disseminate learning within their own discipline (e.g. local conversations)
- Submit the completed Erasmus+ Delta Scholarship enhancement form
